## The K-12 Visual Arts curriculum addresses the following goals:

**GOAL #1:** Create (imagine, experiment, plan, make, evaluate, refine and present/exhibit) art works that express concepts, ideas and feelings in each art form.

**GOAL #2:** Respond (select, experience, describe, analyze, interpret and evaluate) with understanding to diverse art works and each art form.

**GOAL #3:** Understand and use the materials, techniques, forms, (structures, styles, genres), language and repertoire of each form.

**GOAL #4:** Understand the importance of the arts in expressing and illuminating human experiences, beliefs and values.

**GOAL #5:** Identify representative works and recognize the characteristics of visual art from different historical periods and cultures.

**GOAL #6:** Develop sufficient master of at least one art form to continue lifelong involvement in that art form not only as responders (audience members), but also as creators.

**GOAL #7:** Develop sufficient mastery of at least one art form to be able to pursue further study, if they choose, in preparation for a career.

**GOAL #8:** Seek arts experiences and participate in the artistic life of the school and community.

**GOAL #9:** Understand the connections among the arts, other disciplines and daily life.
