1. Discussion re: ELPS Camp Phenomena (Summer 2017) Review

Niantic Center School teacher Diane Swan and Flanders teacher Lisa Vaudreuil reviewed with the Board the Camp Phenomena from July 31 to August 11, 2017 as a summer camp experience to include enrichment outcomes, an overall reflection of the program and reforms for next year, and parent survey results.

They stated it was a great opportunity for students and hope the program will be expanded next summer. Superintendent Newton and the Board thanked the teachers for their work and commitment to the program.


