

Non-Instructional Operations

Transportation

The Board of Education will provide transportation for pupils under provisions of the state law and regulations. The Superintendent of Schools is asked to administer the operation so as to:

1. Provide for reasonable and desirable transportation of pupils.
2. Supplement and reinforce desirable pupil behavior patterns.
3. Assist handicapped pupils appropriately in compliance with individual education program specifications.
4. Enrich the instructional program through carefully planned field trips in accordance with Policy 6153.
5. Meet reasonable goals of safety and efficiency.
