In conjunction with the Superintendent, Administration and Staff the BOE will support the following outlined four district goals:

Pathways Programming: The BOE will support the district's development of community partnerships and advancing student learning through community-based experiences and career/technical education learning opportunities. Additionally, the board will support the exploration, development, and further expansion of career concentration programs at East Lyme High School.

Culture and Climate Progression: Support the district and school initiatives to advance in a safe, nurturing, and inclusive environment that is responsive to all stakeholders in a climate of high expectation. In addition, The BOE will continue to support increased involvement with AAA (Climate/Culture), DEI (Diversity, Equity and Inclusion) and SEL (Social & Emotional Learning) based efforts that further inspire, engage, and help educate our students.

High Level Instructional Practices, Assessment, Growth/Development for

Students: The BOE will collaborate with administration to support the further achievement and development of all students through high impact and evidenced-based teaching practices, which in turn will promote greater student growth. Additionally, through exceptional programming and support the East Lyme Public Schools will further define our effectiveness in bringing forth responsible, independent, and critical thinkers.

District Marketing and Branding: The BOE will partner with administration to explore and identify revenue opportunities, while increasing efforts at marketing and branding our district.
