#### III. PUBLIC COMMENT

- 1. Lisa Opsahl, 7 Wilbur Lane Niantic, President of the Drug and Alcohol Free Committee, spoke in support of a June 18, 2015 ELHS graduation date for the class of 2015.
- 2. David Tretter, 21 Brainard Road Niantic, expressed concerns regarding unacceptable ELHS baseball field conditions, transportation costs to Dodd Stadium, inconvenience parents and disappointed players and asked Superintendent Newton to rectify the situation.
- 3. Rocco Tricarico, 17 Rose Lane Niantic, articulated concerns regarding ongoing neglect of the East Lyme High School baseball field and noted that kids and the taxpayers of East Lyme deserve better. - 6. Kathryn Tretter, 21 Brainard Road Niantic, encouraged the Board to look into asking the East Lyme Parks and Recreation Department to maintain the HS baseball field.

# 4. <u>Discussion/action re: Proposed Reinstatement of the Suspended Elementary Global Language Program and Extension of the Elementary School Day</u>

The Board continued discussion regarding the reinstatement of the suspended Elementary Global Language Program effective the start of the 2015-2016 school year. The improved elementary program will provide Grade 3 and 4 students with a minimum of 60 minutes a week of instruction in French and/or Spanish. An adjustment in elementary and middle schools times is required. Funds for the two instructors will be covered by revenue from the East Lyme–Xiangjiang Cooperative Agreement.
