1. Discussion re: Update on Elementary School Projects

Superintendent Newton reported that the Design Steering Committee met last week to review the costs associated with basic renovations needed at Flanders, Lillie B. Haynes, and Niantic Center Schools. A punch list of additional needs will be developed for all three schools.

A BOE Committee of the Whole Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, November 10, 6:00 p.m. in Room B101, ELHS. Dr. Don Kennedy of NESDEC will provide updated enrollment projects and Al Jacunski will provide updated elementary facility information. The meeting will be televised.

2. <u>Discussion re: Elementary Level Redistricting Option for the 2017/2018</u> School Year

Superintendent Jeff Newton walked the Board through preliminary information pertaining to the redistricting option for K-4 elementary students for the 2017/2018 school year.

Board members were supportive of the formation of a committee to further investigate this option. Membership will consist of two Board members, Superintendent Newton, Finance and Facilities Director Maria Whalen, an ELTA representative, the three elementary principals, two staff members, two parents from each elementary school, and representative of First Student (bus company).

Suggestions included equalizing student enrollment among the three elementary schools while allowing for growth in new housing development areas (e.g., Flanders) and developing an aggressive timeline ensuring the plan is finalized before the 2016-2017 school year ends.
