A. Finance/Facilities/Community

1. Discussion re: Update on Infinite Campus

Technology Director Pat Lannon updated the Board on the progress of the Infinite Campus rollout and the portal usage since January 1 by students and parents. Pat Lannon reported that the Demographics piece of Infinite Campus is completed.

Percentages of ELPS parents without accounts are as follows:

- Flanders 46%
- Haynes 56%
- Niantic Center 60% (corrected)
- Middle School 15%
- High School 44%

Information includes student attendance and grades. Data bases will soon be linked for the food service system (tracking free and reduced and student food purchases), nurses, and IEP Direct. Other data bases to be linked later this year include library, High School to College and Career, and transportation.

Some Board members spoke on the importance of setting clear and firm goals for parent usage rates and for teachers consistently using Infinite Campus for student attendance and as an ongoing grade book.

Pat Lannon noted that teacher coaches are available in each building, an App is coming, and student mobile registrations should be in place for fall 2017.

2. <u>Discussion re: Update on Alteration Project for the Three East Lyme Elementary</u> Schools

Chair Tim Hagen announced that due to impending weather, the March 14 Town Referendum has been canceled. At Wednesday's meeting, the Board of Selectmen is expected to authorize the First Selectman to call a Special Town Meeting on March 21 and a Town Referendum on March 28, 2017.
