 - 1. <u>Discussion/action re: Proposed Appointment of Director of finance, Marketing, and Growth Management Effective June 19, 2017</u>

Superintendent Newton recommended the appointment of Ms. Maryanna Stevens for the position of Director of Finance, Marketing, and Growth Management effective June 19, 2017.

MOTION: Jaime Barr Shelburn moved to appoint Maryanna Stevens to the position of 1.0 FTE Director of Finance, Marketing, and Growth Management for East Lyme Public Schools effective June 19, 2017 through June 30, 2018 and to authorize the Superintendent to enter into a contract agreement; Eric Bauman seconded.

B. Finance/Facilities/Community

1. <u>Discussion re: Informational Presentation by Eversource Re: Continuation of Natural Gas Line from ELHS to Flanders School and Central Office</u>

Eversource representative Lu Ann Dinihanian gave an informational presentation regarding the benefits of continuing the natural gas line from East Lyme High School to Flanders School and Central Office at no cost to the Board of Education. The installation would take place over the summer and be completed prior to the start of school. The proposal will be forwarded to the FFO Committee for discussion and sent back to the BOE for a decision. Town officials are onboard with this cost saving plan.

2. <u>Discussion/action re: Proposed One-Year Contract Extension for School Medical Advisor Effective July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2018</u>

Superintendent Newton recommended a one-year contract extension for the continuation of services by Dr. Vijay Sikand as the School Medical Advisor for ELPS effective July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 at the unchanged cost of \$20,000.

MOTION: Jaime Barr Shelburn moved to authorize the Superintendent to sign a one-year contract with Dr. Vijay Sikand for his services as the East Lyme Public Schools' Medical Advisor for the period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 at the cost of \$20,000 as presented; Barbara Senges seconded.

3. <u>Discussion re: ELPS Elementary School Alteration Projects Update</u>

Chair Tim Hagen and Superintendent Newton updated the Board on the next steps for the elementary schools' alteration projects. The Board of Selectmen met on May 17, 2017 to discuss and approve a Town Resolution required for the state's application process for a school construction grant. An ordinance will be needed to allow two BOE members to serve on the building committee and a slight modification to the BOE Charter may be needed. A RFQ for Project Manager is being prepared. Filing with the state is on schedule for the June 30, 2017 deadline.

4. Discussion re: Elementary Redistricting Ad hoc Committee Update

The BOE Elementary Redistricting Ad hoc Committee met on May 22, 1017 and Facilitator Amy Drowne and Superintendent Newton provided an update of its work.

Following an overview of the school alteration projects, each of the five subgroups were asked to revisit their action plans and identify a timeline before January 2018. Subgroups were in agreement on the following:

- 1) Additional stakeholders need to be brought to the table to answer questions and partake in decision making.
- 2) Knowledge on how the Project Manager will logistically sequence the three elementary alteration projects is essential before developing a redistricting plan.

The committee will meet again in fall 2017. Board members reiterated their commitment to balancing the three elementary schools in the least impactful way possible and to readjust as necessary.

Board discussion was centered on committing to take specific action for a time-bound plan for redistricting at the next Board meeting.

Assistant Superintendent Amy Drowne shared with the Board the draft ELPS Educator Evaluation and Support Plan for 2017-2018 along with a summary of the changes made from the current plan to align with the district's strategic plan.

The Board thanked the Professional Development Evaluation Committee for its work and the CEA for its feedback.

The plan will be submitted to the CT State Department of Education for approval and then resubmitted to the Board of Education for adoption.

 East Lyme High School Principal Mike Susi presented the proposed East Lyme High School Student/Parent Handbook for 2017/2018 and outlined the major changes from the current year:

 - An updated section on Senior Late Arrival/Early Dismissal Privilege
 - Updated information regarding BOE policy changes

Eric Bauman requested that discussion regarding GPA weighting and graduation requirements be included as future AAA Committee agenda items.
