Welcome: Steve Hargis called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Public comment: Two individuals representing Nutmeg came late to the meeting and voiced their concerns during the meeting.

Approval of minutes: The minutes of the May 7, 2018 meeting were reviewed and accepted per a motion by Jan Logozzo and seconded by Nancy Burkhardt; motion passed unanimously.

POOL UPDATE: Rob Bouchey reported that the HVAC construction project is currently on target with removal of old equipment and prep for installation of the new system. A conversion from propane to natural gas will also occur this summer. Jeff Newton reported that if money is available, a new boiler will be installed, replacing the original boiler.

Jeff Newton explained the new structure of pool management and finances, which will be under the Board of Education and the Financial Director of East Lyme Public Schools. This change is to better ensure a profitable organization. Regarding the pool and the Nutmeg, they are two segments. Nutmeg was a separate program started by Jack Staubach and is owned by his company. The

company is presently being bought out from Jack by Rob Bouchey, who is committed to the continuation of the program.

Brett Hammen discussed in detail issues Nutmeg parents have regarding the program. Jeff Newton said he hears what the Nutmeg concerns are, and they will be considered in ongoing discussions this summer with the ad hoc committee regarding the pool structure and finances

At the September meeting of the Pool Committee, there will be more clarity on management structure and finances.

A review of the attached East Lyme Aquatic Management Profit and Loss, July 2017 through June 2018, statement was reviewed. Per Jack Staubach's contract, if a certain profit was made, he was entitled to a bonus. As this amount was not met, no bonus will be paid for the 2017-2018 fiscal year. The contract with Jack Staubach terminates July 1, 2018, with his retirement from pool management.
