

Free Breakfast and Lunch for All East Lyme Public Schools Students

U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Sonny Perdue announced the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) will extend several flexibilities through as late as June 30, 2021. The flexibilities allow National School Lunch Program operators to continue serving **free** meals to all children into the fall months. This unprecedented move will help ensure – no matter what the situation is on-the-ground – children have access to nutritious food as the country recovers from the COVID-19 pandemic. USDA has been and continues to be committed to using the Congressionally appropriated funding that has been made available.

All East Lyme Public School Students will receive Free Breakfast and Lunch. This applies to In-school and virtual home school students.

****District Wide Breakfast will be a Grab and Go service when they arrive on Campus.**

**** Elementary Lunch will be ordered in the classroom for any student who wants lunch and will be delivered by Lunch Program Staff in the Café.**

****Middle and High School Lunch follow regular day service in Café during in school days.**

****Hybrid 3-day and 5-day Students will have Free meal pickups at see schedule below**

****Virtual 5-Day Students can also pick up at Middle School.**
