Redistricting plans continue to move forward for our three elementary schools with implementation occurring for the 2019-2020 school year. The East Lyme Board of Education has been engaging in conversation regarding these plans, and will meet to further discuss this topic on Monday evening, April 2, 2018. We want all parents to be aware that a full Community Forum is scheduled for **Thursday, April 12, 2018, 6:00 p.m.**, in the Mary Broderick Auditorium at East Lyme High School.

The district has been actively working this year with an outside firm (Milone & MacBroom) to develop the redistricting plans that will provide an appropriate balance for all kindergarten through grade four students across the district. This plan is focused around ensuring the long term sustainability and future growth of our elementary schools, while also being least impactful to families and students.

We also encourage you to join us at the scheduled forum on April 12.
